



USY Poland Seminar for Adults 2017

July 4-11, 2017

General Information

USY has sponsored trips to Israel and Europe since 1956. Thirty years ago USY launched its highly successful Israel Pilgrimage/Poland Seminar, followed by other European options a few years later. For many years parents of USY participants asked us to plan trips to Poland for adults. In response to those requests we launched our USY Poland Seminar for Adults in 2013. Our itinerary and programming is similar to that of the programs we run for high school and college students. The primary emphasis is on sites of Jewish interest, focusing on the rich and varied history of Polish Jewry. This is combined with a special focus on the Holocaust period. The details below include the tentative itinerary as well as the cost of the trip and other important information.

Cost

The total price for land arrangements in Poland is **\$2785** per person based on double occupancy. The single occupancy supplement is **\$380**.

Flights

The cost does not include flights. Please arrange your own flights, and plan to arrive in Warsaw by 11am on Tuesday, July 4, 2017. If you need any guidance regarding flights please don't hesitate to contact us. (Do not reserve any flights until we have notified you that we have reached our minimum number of participants)

Land Package Includes

7 nights' accommodations at comfortable (3-4 star) hotels: 3 nights in Warsaw, 1 night in Lublin, 3 nights in Krakow.

Full Board Kosher meals, mineral water on the bus at all times, entrance fees to all museums and sites, local guides, USY Tour educator (guide), gratuities for European drivers and guides, deluxe tour bus and more.

Exclusions

The price does not include , flights , ground transportation in North America , medical and travel insurance , spending money , Please note that if you arrive in / depart from Warsaw on dates / times other than those listed on the itinerary you will be responsible for your own ground transportation to/from the airport. USY



will not be responsible for sites or programming missed due to individual flight schedules.

Eligibility

The trip is open to adults 24 years and over who wish to participate in a program reflecting USY's approach to religious practice and education. Participants must declare that they are in good medical and physical health and able to walk unassisted for considerable distances in weather that can be very hot or rainy. The minimum number of participants needed for this trip is 20. US reserves the right to limit the number of participants and will accept people who submit a completed reservation form with a deposit (see payment schedule below) on a first come first served basis.

Payment Schedule

To secure your reservation please submit your registration form (one form per applicant) and a check for \$400 per person payable to USY. The deposit should be submitted by March 1, 2017. A bill for the remainder of your fees based upon the information on the registration form will be sent to you. The balance of payment will be due by April 20, 2017.

Cancellation

Until March 1, 2017 all fees, including the deposit will be refunded.

March 2 - April 3 \$100 administrative fee will be deducted

April 4 - 20 75% refund

April 21 - May 15 50% refund

May 16 onward, no refund
